## FOUR ATTRIBUTES OF FAMILIES WHO PASS FAITH GENERATIONALLY

August 6, 2017

I'm using the article space to tie into the sermons for this week and last. Below is a reminder of the four attributes of families who pass faith down through the generations. If you wish, you could clip and keep as a reminder of for what we all should strive as a first priority for our families to be the kind of families that keep the 'family fire' burning through the ages. The four attributes are listed below along with a brief description of each.

- 1. Putting First Things First (Spiritual Priority)** - Parents need to clearly demonstrate through actions and how they use their time and resources that spiritual things come first. Not work, not play, not sports, not recreation, nothing comes before our commitment to the Lord. There may be times when exceptions must be made but they should be the clear exception and not the rule in words as well as action.
- 2. Radical Holiness** - Christian families should stand out to the world. They should be different in recognizable ways. They should always be humble and kind about their differences and the reasons behind them but be unapologetic about not compromising Christian values like purity and integrity for any reason. This doesn't mean that they never make mistakes but when they make mistakes it does mean that they confess them and seek to make them right.
- 3. Communion with God** - Families of faith should be in communion with God daily. Too often the connection with God is left for Sunday and Wednesday nights as "church times." Regular worship, prayer, scripture reading and discussion on application cannot be a once or twice a week thing. Families should strive to bring worship and devotional activities to their daily schedule. Communion with God in the home is a crucial activity in discipling children and in helping them to cling to their faith as they leave the home.
- 4. A Heart for Service** - The best way to see value in yourself is to make a positive difference in the life of someone else. Children who grow up in families that value service and make regular opportunities as a family to serve others see a bigger picture of the world outside of themselves. They focus less on their own needs and more on the needs of others. They build self-esteem not just through parental compliments and encouragement from peers but also from the hard evidence provided when they see a smile on the face of another because of a task they have completed. When they learn to love service, they learn what it is to be the hands and feet of Jesus in the world.

I hope families will work to build these attributes into their families to the point that they define their families. In doing so they will be moving steadily toward that goal of passing faith in God and the gospel of Jesus Christ down through the generations.
