STEP UP AND STEP IN

The simplicity of a Youth Ministry program can get mixed up by past experiences. West Side has had rich youth ministry programs that were full of students that have a deep church backgrounds in family settings. Historically, the demographics were more similar than diverse seemingly without much extreme. Currently our program can be charted by extreme differences in the social, economic and spiritual demographics. From a ministerial standpoint, this is exciting and very much why my family and I walked into full-time ministry. West Side has a missional vision to love others, share the gospel message and to make disciples. Through prayer, God is bringing students into our programming that do not not fully look like our past demographics. Which can be difficult for some of us that have intentionally parented students. Our Youth Group environment can quickly look like our student's school environment. Scary to think about. School is filled with sinful worldly behaviors that we have historically said has no place in the church. I would say it's our time to shine West Side, it's our time to step into our programming and teach our students what it means to have the Love of Christ, to Share the Gospel message and the Disciple these new students. In the short time, Sandi and I have been at West Side it is evident that we have some strong families and some families that can be encouraged by our strong families. Success requires us to come together at the same time frequently. It is our goal to have a stronger group dynamic. This naturally happens when we come together often in situations where we are forced to depend on each other. Our student gatherings and camps offer such opportunities.

Every time we read about Jesus we can be amazed about the wide range of people in his ministry. As mentioned in his Great Commission he directs his followers to go and teach, baptize and make disciples. It is a simple concept, isn't it? Then why is it that we tend to make it so complex and difficult? Consider this, it is because we like what we like and we don't want to mess with it. Meaning, we get comfortable in a rhythm and design that has worked in the past with our children and it should work with these newer generations. But the reality is our programming of the past was designed to attract a certain demographic and relate to that environment. The current direction seems that we are wanting to reach everyone just as Jesus gave by example. When we reach out into the community things look different and they start to look like the Kingdom of God and less like an institution for a certain group of people.

Church please let me encourage you to step up and step in to our children/youth programming and build relationships for the long-term spiritual impact. Yes, they will frustrate you and they will love you. Consider Mark 10:17-31.
