Leading the Charge by Mark Hixson

Shortly after his resurrection, Jesus calls everyone to the mountain. He lays out 'The Great Commission' for all to hear. This missional message is about replication. The replication of the teachings God wants all his people to adhere to is to go into the world, make disciples by baptizing and teaching everyone to obey the instructions of Jesus.

Can you imagine being around in the time Jesus' ministry? Much less on the mountain when Jesus is talking about "The Great Commission?" The energy that comes when seeing the great teacher alive and well? Kind of gets you excited, doesn't it?

I can imagine Peter sitting on go, ready to rally everyone together on this big loud, noisy campaign. Especially coming off of a time when they witnessed their teacher being put on trial and then crucified. He was going to baptize tens of people. Yet in Acts 1, Jesus asks the disciples to wait for a gift from God. This 'gift' would resemble a baptism but not with water this time, it would be that of the Holy Spirit. Jesus was intentional in informing them they need to be lead by the Holy Spirit of God and not on their own energies.

Consider this, if the Great Spirit didn't show its self in Acts 2 would the disciple had the impact they are having? When the spirit of the Lord baptized these disciples a great crowd approached, everyone who had a heart to hear was immediately humbled at the sights and sounds from what was happening. What's the result? Something we cannot do on our own.

As we continue in our series on the 'Mission and Vision' of the church, let's recognize the activities of what it means to be lead by the Spirit of God. Let us be prayful in our readings and journaling. Let's ask good questions. Most of all let's be a people lead by the Spirit of God.
