ASHLI ROUSSEL - STREAMS IN BURKINA FASO

November 19th, 2017

Ashli Roussel is from Little Rock and graduated from Harding University with a degree in nursing and health care missions in 2013. She worked as a labor and delivery nurse for two years before moving to Burkina Faso in 2015 to join the Streams in Burkina Faso team that is ministering to the Dagara people group. Ashli has now lived and served in Burkina Faso for three years, and although she loves being involved in all of the ministries of her team, she works most closely with the infants in distress program, medical cases, and children's ministry. Apart from loving Africa, she also enjoys the outdoors, camping, running, playing music, watching sunrises and sunsets, and hanging in her hammock. Her favorite verse that she seeks to live by is John 10:10 where Jesus says, "I have come that they may have life and have it abundantly."

She battled an eating disorder at the age of seventeen that radically transformed her life and relationship with God. Her story of struggle, faith in Christ, surrender, and victory through the power of God and His Word is shared in her published book, *Boundless: Discovering God in Your Eating Disorder*. She is passionate about writing and speaking in order to share hope and healing in the name of the Lord with other young women battling eating.

Streams in Burkina Faso serves the Dagara people group, and their vision is **to see a vibrant body of Christ in every Dagara village transforming their community from darkness to light**. Their ministries focus on working together with more than 40 local churches and leaders to impact the Dagara people and their neighbors with the gospel of Jesus.

Leadership training - Training local church leaders to spread the word of God and plant churches.

Children's ministry - Training local men and women to lead village children's ministries, plus a weekly kids' club with Bible-based teaching and activities.

Infants in distress - A program for orphaned, abandoned, and malnourished children under the age of two that supports extended families and foster families with the resources needed, such as powdered milk and medical care, to take care of these babies.

Literacy training - Exposing people to the Word of God and enriching their communities through literacy.

Medical outreach - Caring for the basic physical and spiritual needs of the community.

Young scholars program - Sponsorship program for orphans and vulnerable girls to continue their education.

Water wells - A partnership with The Water Project that rehabilitates and installs clean water wells.

Ashli will be speaking in the Chapel this evening, November 19, at 5:00 PM for all those that would like to join, meet her, and hear her speak.
