February 25th, 2018

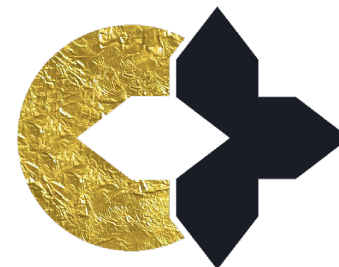
