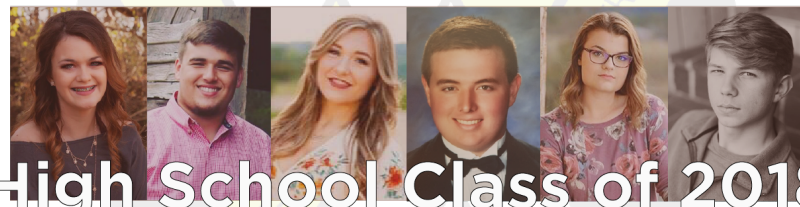
A NEW SEASON
