THE BIGGEST MISCONCEPTION COLLEGE STUDENTS HAVE ABOUT CHURCH

I want to give a big **WELCOME BACK** to all of our Arkansas Tech Students! If you are new to Tech or just new to the CCSC and West Side, we offer you a special welcome! One of the very best things about being at West Side is the special relationships shared between college students and individuals and families who live in Russellville and are here all year. We are thankful that you have chosen to be with us this morning and hope that you will continue to call West Side your church home while you are studying at ATU and beyond.

I have worked with youth groups, college students and young adults for much of my ministry career and I know that with some consistency some young adults, college students in particular, tend to have one big misconception about church while in college. Their misconception is this: they tend to believe that their role in the church is insignificant and unimportant. College students often believe that what they can do for the church is minimal, and that the people in the church are indifferent to their attendance. The problem is that this belief is untrue. The belief that they are not needed here also tends to enable things like less participation, a lower priority for spiritual endeavors and less of a focus on growing faith. The fact is this church is **thrilled** that they are here and we genuinely miss them when gone.

In his first letter to Timothy, the apostle Paul encouraged him not to view his youthful efforts as insignificant. He said, "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity," (1 Timothy 4:12). He is saying that even though you are young, the example you set in how you live life and pursue faith is often more significant than you know. There are few things more inspiring than a young adult earnestly seeking to enhance and grow his or her faith in Christ. We encourage you to make the CCSC and West Side the platform and context for your faith to grow this year.

Students who get involved in the CCSC and in activities at church play a pivotal role in efforts to spread the good news of Jesus and His love. Jesus can be clearly seen in many of you and we hope you see him displayed when you worship here or participate in any of our activities. Most importantly we want you to know that you are important here. We are inspired and encouraged each time you attend a service or show up at an activity. We hope you will worship with us every Sunday, attend classes here, join the midweek service at the CCSC and get involved with the work going on here to take the good news about Jesus to the world.

To those who have been here in years past, we look forward to hearing about your summer and what the Lord has been doing in your life over the past few months. To those who are here for the first time, or the first time in a long time, we look forward to getting to know you and working with you for the glory of God and the good of His kingdom.
