## HONOR THE SON

I read a parable in Matthew chapter 22:1-14 recently and a character in the story really made me think. The parable is about a king who prepares a wedding banquet for his son. He invites the dignitaries and movers and shakers to the wedding but when they are called to the feast, they refuse. Some even mistreat or kill his messengers. The king sends his army to wipe out the ungrateful murderers and sends his messengers back into the streets to invite the street people, the ordinary people to come to the banquet. Many come, both good people and bad. The king comes to the banquet to greet the guests and notices a man there who is not wearing wedding clothes. He confronts the man and then has him thrown out of the banquet and into darkness.

So who is this ingrate who would come to the wedding banquet of a prince wearing street clothes? We don't know who he is but we know why he is there. He is there for the free food and drink. He heard there was a party at the palace and knew there would be good food and wine there. The problem was that was not why the king invited him to come. The king invited him because he wanted people there to honor his son on his wedding day. Jesus said that the 'Kingdom of Heaven' is like this.

The lesson is clear. If you come to the king's banquet for free food, you are not there to honor the son. Many followed Jesus during his ministry because they received healing or they ate when he provided food miraculously. He called them out on it too. He reminded them that there are costs to following him. Those following, those coming to the "King's banquet" will one day have to pick up their cross and follow him. Its unlikely that those who are there for the free food will be willing to do that. Those who come to honor the son will.

We are still all invited to the 'banquet' today. We know we don't want to be the man who was discovered at the feast in street clothes. We don't want to be exposed as Christian wedding crasher. I'll put it bluntly. Heaven, grace, forgiveness, mercy, God's love, Christ's sacrifice and eternal life are all on the table of the banquet. But if that is what you are coming for; if all you want is to avoid hell, or indulge in selfish, worldly desires because you know God's grace will cover you, you may be wearing street clothes. The banquet is prepared and all are invited but only those who are there to honor the son will please the king.

"For many are invited but few are chosen." (Matthew 22:14)
